A: The programme typically spans 18 to 24 months, including the completion of an operational workplace project and the End-Point Assessment (EPA).

Q: Is this programme eligible for UK Apprenticeship Levy funding?

A: Yes. Employers paying the UK Apprenticeship Levy can utilise their funds to cover 100% of the training costs, while non-levy employers receive up to 95% government funding.

Q: How is this program tailored specifically to Flight Operations?

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A: While covering core Level 4 management principles, all assignments, case studies, and practical projects are contextualised around the specialised environment of an airline Operations Control Centre (OCC).
